## **SUPPLEMENTAL DISABILITY AND WORKERS COMPENSATION BENEFIT**

*Please see the section of this Summary Plan Description entitled “Claims Procedure” for information about claiming this benefit.*

### **Eligibility for the Benefit**

To be eligible for the Supplemental Disability and Workers Compensation Benefit for a week, you must:

1. Be Disabled and have been receiving Loss of Time Benefits for the past six weeks under the I.B.E.W. 292 Health Care Plan (the “Health Care Plan”) or under an I.B.E.W./NECA health care plan that has entered into a reciprocal agreement with the Health Care Plan; or
2. Receiving workers compensation benefits for the week (after having been Disabled for the prior six weeks).

### **Amount of the Benefit**

The Supplemental Disability and Workers Compensation Benefit is \$250 per week until your account balance reaches the minimum of \$25.

### **When Paid**

The Supplemental Disability and Workers Compensation Benefits will commence payment starting in the seventh week of your Disability.
